Membaca merupakan salah satu hal yang penting untuk dipelajari oleh anak.

Berikut adalah tips dan trik cara mengajar anak yang dapat dicoba di rumah:



1 Bermain permainan kata (tebak kata, Guess My Word, Pictionary, kata tersembunyi)

2 Belajar membaca dengan metode phonic

3 Membacakan buku cerita, menanyakan pertanyaan pemahaman & berdiskusi

4 Menunjuk bacaan dengan jari

5 Berlatih dengan kata-kata yang mirip dan pengertiannya

6 Gunakan bermacam cara untuk mengajarkan arti kosa kata pada anak (analogi, sinonim, konteks, gambar visual)

7 Membuat tulisan dengan ukuran besar dan diberi jarak sehingga lebih mudah dibaca

8 Membaca bergantian dengan anak

9 Buat kebiasaan membaca berita setiap hari (pilih cerita yang pendek dan menarik bagi anak, seperti teknologi / cerita inspirasi)

DID YOU KNOW?



Seringkali, kesulitan membaca dapat berkaitan dengan: pengertian kata, memecah bunyi kata, kelancaran, dan kosa kata.

Faktor lain yang mungkin berkaitan adalah konsentrasi, ingatan, dan berbahasa asing.

SIMPLE TIPS & TRICKS TO HELP YOUR KIDS LOVE READING

Reading is one of the most important skills for children to learn. Here are some tips and tricks to teach reading which you can do at home:



1 Play word games (Charades, Guess my Word, Pictionary, hidden words)

2 Learning and practicing phonic methods of reading

3 Reading stories to kids, asking comprehension & discussion questions

4 Tracing the letters on the book

5 Practicing similar words and their meanings

6 Using several ways to teach the meaning of new words (e.g. analogies, synonyms, context, picture, etc.)

7 Read stories with bigger font sizes and larger space between the words

8 Repeating materials until it sticks (if there is retention problem)

9 Make a habit to read news together every day. It can be a short or interesting ones (technologies, human interest, etc.)
